DOES IT WORK?	Stayed on well in wet and sweaty conditions, and no testers burned	Some testers came back a bit pink — even on shaded cenote dive	Effective, but greasy Kabuki look wasn't a hit with testers	Required reapplication but offered generally effective protection	Mixed results: Some testers burned even with reapplication
EASY TO USE?	As easy to apply as any of the common chemical brands	A little thicker than chemical screens; good overall absorbency	Clouds of white film washed off when our testers hit the water	Thin, milklike consistency made this a messy one to apply	Get ready to rub — and still to be white and greasy hours later
WHAT ELSE?	A terrific find; we plan to use nothing else from here on out	Only moderate rubbing required; pleasant lavender scent a plus	The fruity-gum smell did not appeal to some adult testers	Our testers were put off by bits of solid matter in the lotion	At \$25 a tube, this was nearly twice the price of most others tested
